Margin Protection

Do not forget to sign up for the new dairy margin insurance program. You have until November 28, 2014 to sign up at your local FSA office. At the time of sign up, you will have to pay \$100.00 administrative fee. The \$100 fee will need to be paid each year through calendar year 2018. If you miss the sign up this year, then you will not be able to increase your historical production base.

Your choices during enrollment: 1) margin protection between \$4.00 - \$8.00/cwt. \$4.00/cwt is free and has escalating costs until you reach \$8.00/cwt margin protection. Coverage is available in \$0.50/cwt increments. 2) Percentage of production history that will be covered. Coverage is available from 25% to 90% in 5 percent increments.

Please remember this is the only government program to help dairy farmers during the bad times. MILC is no longer operating.
